GEMS STONES AS A SOUVENIR FOR GUESTS AND PARTICIPANTS OF THE ASIAN-AFRICAN CONFERENCE IN BANDUNG AS A SOUVENIR

Gems Stones have been a trending topic in Indonesia to date. Especially, since the Mayor of Bandung, Ridwan Kamil has given gems stones as a souvenir for the guests and participants of the 60th Asian African Conference in Bandung.

Mr. Ridwan Kamil prepared the blue gems stone namely Batu Raja (Kings Stone) that were given to the political figures and the state leaders who attended the 60th Asian African Conference in Bandung.

The souvenir was presented in a small cosmetic box along with batik from Bandung.

The phenomenon of gems stones in Indonesia is occurring after the discovery of a jade boulder weighing 20 tons worth about a billion rupiah in districts of Beutong, Nagan Raya, Aceh, recently.

Batu Raja itself has been known since the 80s which was found in Batu Raja, a district of Lengkiti, Ogan Ogan Ulu, in South Sumatera. This stone is included in a category of Chalcedony which has beautiful colours like a blue sky, and it is very expensive. Further, this type of stone is the one that was given to the Head of States and guests that attend the Asian African Conference on 24 April 2015.(su)
